Implementing Google Slides Activities in your Classroom

This is a brief overview of Google Slides implementation ideas. Students can access their Slides anywhere, on any device and at any time. The only thing they need is access to the Internet.



Task Challenge/Activity

- Use Slides as a Presentation app. Users can take advantage of the ready-to-use templates.
- Students can share their slide deck with group members for class projects. They can simultaneously and asynchronously work on their projects during and after class time.
- Use add-ons to enhance the user experience. For example, Pear Deck adds audience participation slides to your slide deck.
- Use the built-in Presentation mode to get immediate audience feedback and questions during a presentation.
- Convert your old Microsoft PowerPoint files to Google Slides by uploading your PowerPoint to Drive → right-clicking on the file → clicking Open with → Slides.
- Create a class yearbook adding one side per student.
- Use hyperlinks to create Jeopardy or a Story creator activities.
- Create a Comic Strip by adding different sized squares or bubble shapes to a slide.
- Use a variety of shapes and lines to create Concept Maps.
- Use shapes and multipliers to create a Manipulatives Math Activity.
