Clicker Books
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice and record reading to scanned book images (Create your own books – teacher provides pictures) • Practice picture taking/recording own voice reading – listen to model then record own • Make Accessible books for class library • Plan a story around a theme and draw pictures, scan or take pictures and write using word banks and emergent writing • Develop oral language and storytelling skills vs writing • Beginning poetry – rhyming words or parts of speech words....describing, action
Clicker Sentences
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Errorless writing (forced order grids) • Following patterns matching words, sequencing choosing correct words • Increase complexity of writing using word banks with Soundshift support (for those who cannot decode but comprehend) • Picture as prompt for sentence meaning/production • Scaffolded writing - model sentence (match) • Model sentence (match from scrambled word order) • No model (write from scrambled words) • Develop auditory memory (hear sentence, recall and write) • Beginning emergent writing from provided phrase with keyboard use, and emergent spelling of own words • Colour support for parts of speech or pattern writing
Clicker Docs
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More advanced writing – keyboard use with auditory support (Soundshift) • Word bank use coupled with keyboard and auditory support (Soundshift) • Personal word banks, theme word banks, A-Z word wall and word prediction
Clicker Connect
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read and choose from more phrases and word combinations provided for writing • Use more complex sentence construction – from grids, supplemented by keyboard use and word grids • Use picture prompts – ELL support • Forced order grids for syntax and pattern recognition • Response writing – like/don't like, has/doesn't have, will/won't
